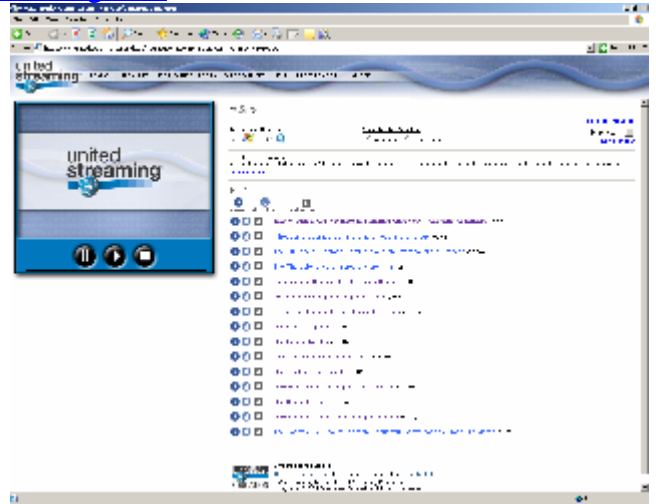


Video Downloads Cheatsheet:

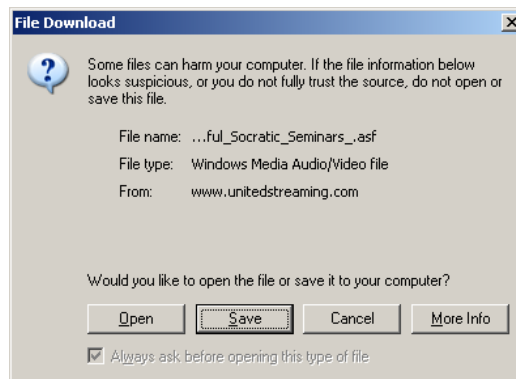
- 1.) Open your Internet browser to www.unitedstreaming.com
- 2.) Login with your username and password.
- 3.) Search or browse for a video of interest.
- 4.) Click on the title of a video to get a list of download options.
- 5.) **s** This button will load the video in that little window for ONE-TIME viewing.
- 6.) **d** This button will download the video to your computer for MULTIPLE viewing.
- 7.) **a** This button will add the video to your play-list so you can come back to it later.



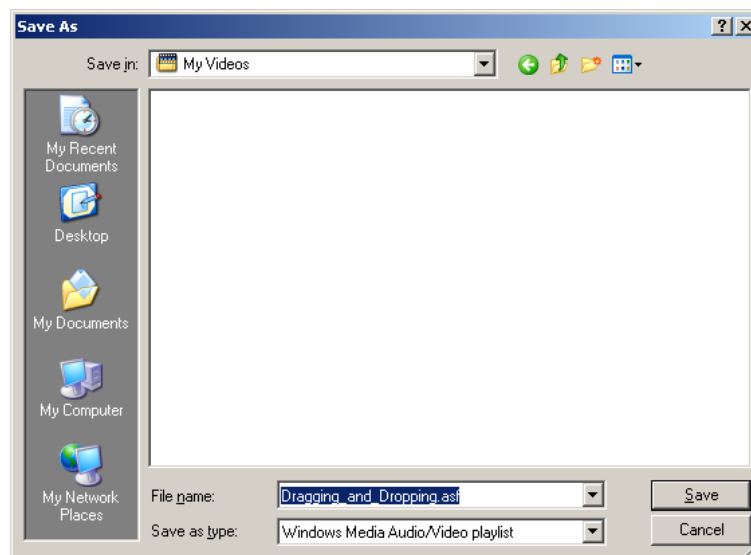
DOWNLOADING:

When you wish to use the video as part of your curriculum, it is best to download the video to your computer or to a CD for repeated use. Using the **s** streaming option seriously slows down the school district's connection, and will not be available once the trial period is over.

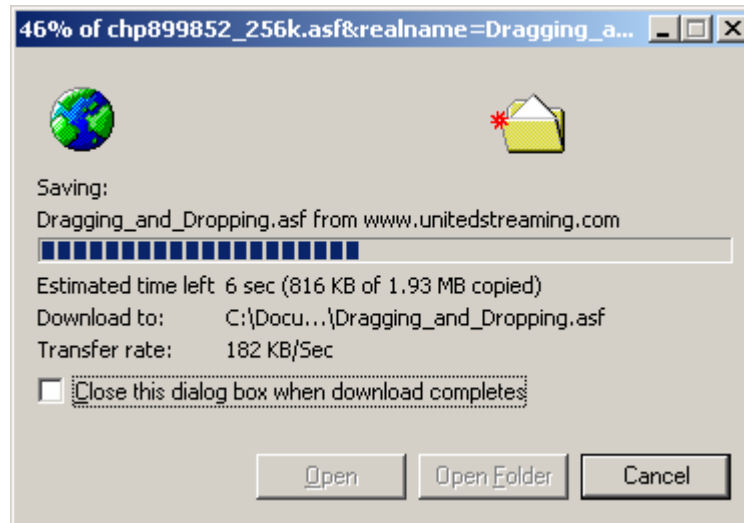
- 1.) Press **d** next to the video you wish to download. You will see this window.



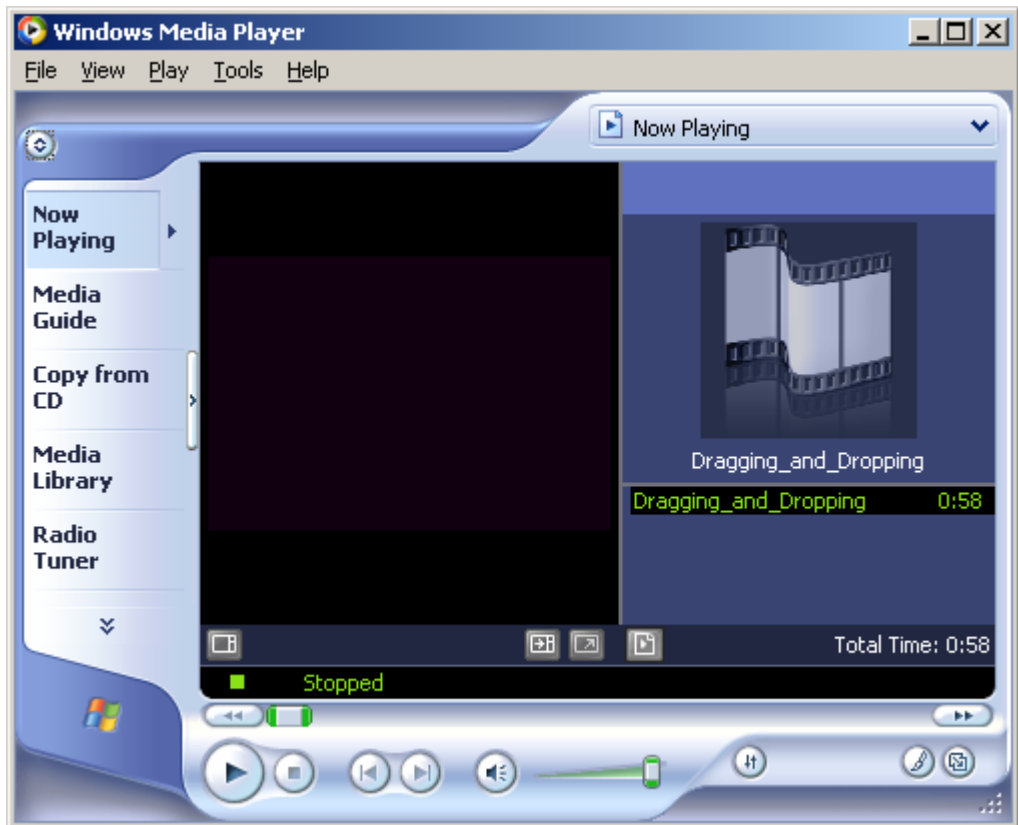
- 2.) Click the 'Save' button.
- 3.) Choose a location on your PC to save the video. I recommend: "My Documents\MyVideos"



- 4.) In the File name box, type in something you'll remember the video by "Wonders of Geometry" or something like that. Make sure to leave the .asf on the end.
- 5.) Click the 'Save' button, you will see the video downloading.



- 6.) To view the file, navigate back to the location you saved it to, and double-click. The most common way to do this is using the 'My Documents' or 'My Computer' icons.



- 7.) The movie should open in some sort of program, and begin playing.
- 8.) Now that it's on your computer, you can return and view it as often as you like.
